Pond	5 year renewable, revocable license, expires in 2011?	As part of the land exchange, RCM will pay the sum of \$1.25 M to the US Forest Service and specify that the F.S. will use funds for construction or improvement to access roads, turnouts, trails, camping, parking areas, and other facilities to promote and enhance rock climbing and bouldering opportunities at the Pond, Upper Pond, Inconceivables and Chill Hill. RCM will transfer The Pond, Dripping Springs and Apache Leap South End to US Dept of Agriculture or US Dept of Interior and specify that these parcels shall be managed so as foster and preserve rock climbing opportunities thereon. This will be written into the legislation.
N of Pond	5 year renewable, revocable license, expires in 2011?	RCM will work w/QC & ADOT to identify and construct safe turnout and access from US60 to Pond, Upper Pond, Upper Pond and Upper Devils Canyon. Wit QCC, RCM will locate and construct roads, parking area and trails prior to transfer to F.S., all in addition to \$1.25M.
Atlantis	none	Extend existing license to 2060, then if not needed RCM will consider transfer to F.S. Or renewal for 10 year periods.
Oak Flat	5 year renewable, revocable license, expires in 2011?	Once RCM get Oak Flat in exchange, it will be under license with Access Fund until 2019 with the option for renewal. Campground open until F.S makes replacement 4 years after signing.

Euro Dog	5-yr renewable, revocable license expires in 2011 [bill: climbing access gone at signing (except Boulderblast for 5 years after signing)]; campground access until sooner of replacement ready or 2 yrs after signing	Post land exchange, RCM will grant a license for public access for rock climbing and bouldering until 2019 with option for renewal. After replacement road for Magma Mine Road is constructed RCM agrees to license Lower Eurodog on long term basis similar to Atlantis.
Mine Area	gone at signing	Post land exchange, RCM will grant a license for public access for rock climbing and bouldering until 2019 with option for renewal.
Apache Leap	gone at signing	RCM will grant license for access from east and west to Apache Leap. All RCM land in Apache Leap will be licensed until 2019 with option to renew. F.S. approval needed for west access.
Upper Devils	conservation easement	Power line road easement or replaced with similar access at RCM expense.
Lower Devils	none	RCM will license road access until 2019 or until new access is available via improved Rawhide Road or improved road fro Hwy 177 to Oak Creek. RCM will assist and encourage F.S. to keep road open for recreational use.
Tamo	State park, \$500k/1M for road. State of Arizona later refused offer.	State or local gov'ts can apply for RPP Act conveyance anytime. After land exchange, RCM will provide \$1M if requested in writing, to develop Tamo climbing.
Inconceivables	none	Part of \$1.25M RCM will give F.S. to construct and improve access roads, trails, turnouts, camping and parking

Homestead et al.	none	RCM agrees to consult climbing community, State and local gov'ts after mining plan approval to create an MOU for RCM to assist with preservation and enhancement of climbing opportunities.
coexistence agreement and climbing management plan	none	Coexistence agreement stating that RCM intends for climbing and mining to co-exist in Queen Creek Canyon Area consistent with safety and mining operations.
Insurance on licenses	we pay 20%	RCM pays or self insures
boulder relocation	none	Open for discussion of limited number of rock and/or vegetation
hardware	none	RCM will provide \$50k per MOU TBD.
green belt	none	RCM will facilitate meetings w/QCC, ADOT, FS, Superior and State to develop long term MOU
